MANITOU GOES GREEN GOLF IS MOVING



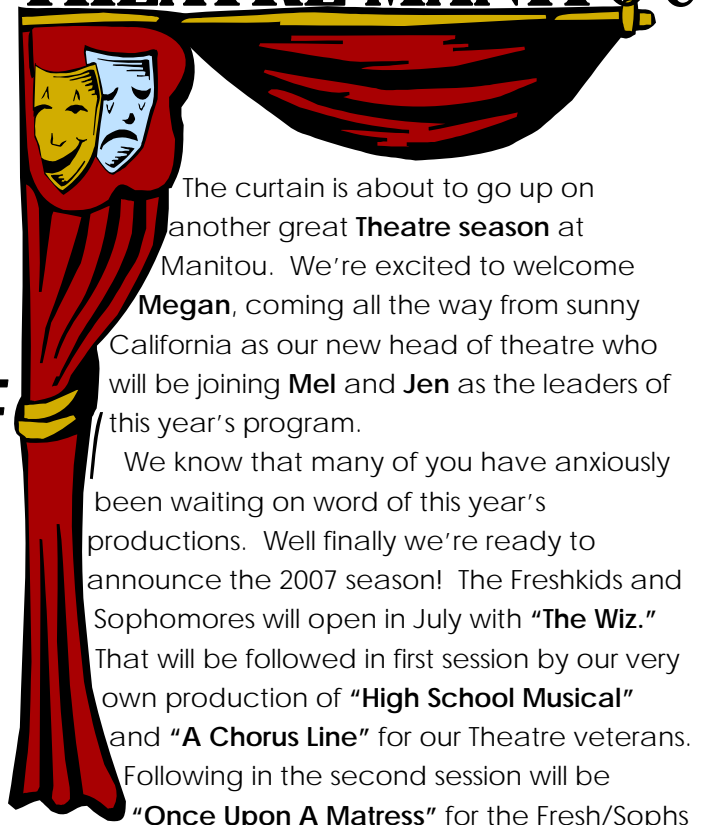

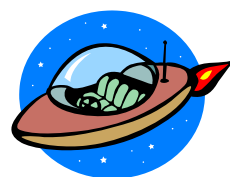


Invasion from Oz
