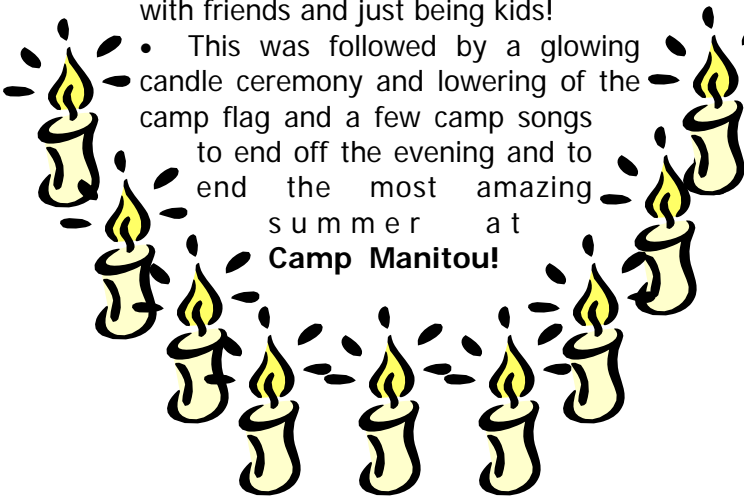
OUT-OF-FOCUS EVENINGS

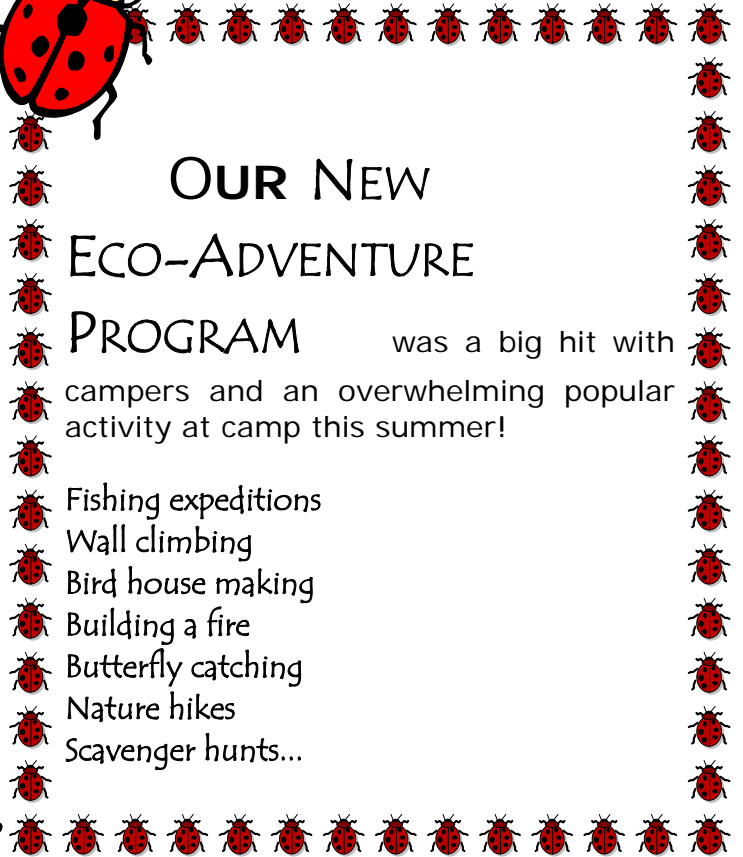
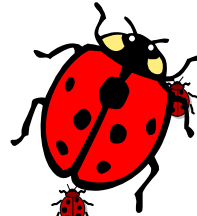
The weekly sign-up also offered an evening of climbing sessions, fishing, baking, bead making, first aid lessons, juggling, guitar lessons and much much more!
